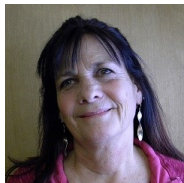

DEPARTMENT RULES & INFORMATION

1. No changes or late entries will be accepted after Aug 1. Up-to-date record book and project book is required by closing date. Please coordinate this with your club or project leader.
2. The Champion Junior & Champion Senior Showmen will be eligible to compete in Round Robin and are encouraged to do so.
3. Exhibitors are to clean-up after their dogs and have fresh water available for their dogs.
4. Dogs are to be kept on a leash at all times while on fairgrounds property except while performing specific exercises inside the performance areas.
5. Dogs must not be left unattended in cars or on the fairgrounds and must depart the fairgrounds after judging is completed.
6. It is recommended that crates be available to dogs to rest in during lengthy time lapses between show classes.
7. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations, including rabies. Please bring proof of whatever vaccine or titer schedule you follow.
8. All exhibitors (and dogs) must be enrolled in a 4-H Dog Project.
9. Exhibitors and their dogs should have attended 80% or more of the countywide dog meetings. If they have not, they must have the superintendent's approval to exhibit at the fair.
10. Dogs will be judged in accordance with modified AKC and 4-H standards.
11. All exhibitors will be expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times and treat others in a courteous manner.
12. Exhibitors are encouraged to enter an appropriate class in each division (1 entry per class). All entries are subject to the superintendent's approval.
13. Any dog showing dog/dog or dog/human aggression will not be permitted to participate.
14. No exhibitor will hit, kick, jerk around or otherwise behave poorly or aggressively towards their dog.
15. Any in-tact male dog must be in full control by the exhibitor at all times.
16. Any intact female must be in full control by the exhibitor and kept away from intact males at all times. Bitch britches are recommended when not in the show ring.
17. All exhibitors must show their own project dog(s) in any class they are entered in.

ALLOWANCES: If 2 exhibitors in the dog program are sharing a dog for their projects, they will each show in their own classes but both may be present in the ring for the group 'sits & downs' exercise. If an exhibitor has more than one dog entered, another 4-H member may present the member's 2nd dog in the ring for the group 'sits and downs' exercises.

EQUIPMENT: Russo or martingale style collars for showmanship, flat or martingale collars for obedience and rally-O, flat style collars for agility; a harness may be used in Family Dog only. No slip collars, choke chains, prong collars, E-collars, or head halters will be allowed. Leads will be an appropriate size in length/diameter for exhibitor/dog combination to handle easily, no horse leads, ropes, etc will be allowed. All collars must fit correctly. An agility collar tag is encouraged for agility.

EXHIBITOR ATTIRE: Closed-toe & heel walking type shoes (clean, no holes tennis shoes are acceptable), dark pants (black or blue), white collared shirt OR AKC style attire as approved by the superintendent. NO SANDALS, SHORTS, TANK TOPS, or SHORT SKIRTS will be permissible. No large distracting earrings or other jewelry (these can be dangerous around animals). Exhibitor's hair should be out of their face or tied back in a professional manner. Costumes are encouraged for freestyle.

(Awards per class: Blue = \$3.00; Red = \$2.00; White = \$1.00)

DIVISION 2600 - SKILL-A-THON

You will be given a set amount of time to test your dog knowledge at the Skill--A--Thon station. This is a silent test you take one person at a time. No dogs allowed.
