### DEPARTMENT RULES

1. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and care of their entries, and keep all alleyways swept clean of debris.
2. Llamas/alpacas must be manageable and well-trained.
3. Animals shall be groomed, clean, hoofs trimmed & free of lice/fleas.
4. 4-H/FFA llamas/alpacas are eligible to enter the Open Class Show.
5. All trailers must be taken off the Fairgrounds.
6. Entries must be fed and watered by 9:00 a.m. daily.
7. Junior members must have turned 8 years old before Oct 1, 2017.
8. Senior members must have turned 13 years old before Oct 1, 2017.
9. Camelid ages are as of the date of judging.

(Awards per class: Blue = \$5.00; Red = \$3.00; White = \$2.00)

#### DIVISION 2550 – HALTER (Light - Medium Wool)

Minimal to medium body and neck wool, smooth heads, ears and legs.

#### DIVISION 2551 - HALTER (Heavy Wool)

Abundant body and neck wool with normal to abundant head and leg wool.

#### DIVISION 2552 - HALTER (Suri Wool)

Open to llamas with the overall draping of fiber forming individual locks

#### DIVISION 2553 - HALTER (Mini Llama)

Open to llamas of any wool type. Juveniles not to exceed 35 inches at the withers; yearlings not to exceed 36 inches at the withers; 2 year olds not to exceed 37 inches at the withers, and mature llamas not to exceed 38 inches at the withers. Llamas may be measured to verify eligibility.

#### DIVISION 2554 - HALTER (Alpaca-Huacaya and Suri)

Judge may separate the Huacaya and Suri division if he/she so desires.

#### Class (for divisions 2250-2554)

1. Juvenile (male or female up to 12 months of age)
2. Yearling Males (13-24 months)
3. Two-Year-Old Males (24-35 months)
4. Mature Males (36 months & older)
5. Yearling Females (13-24 months)

6. Two-Year-Old Females (24-35 months)
7. Mature Females (36 months & older)
8. Gelding (any age)

#### DIVISION 2555 HALTER (Walking Fiber Llama/Alpaca)

Judging on fiber only. Must leave some fiber on animal for it to be properly judged. May be any age or gender.

#### Class

1. Classic
2. Light-Medium Fiber
3. Heavy Fiber
4. Suri Fiber Llama
5. Huacaya/Suri Alpaca Fiber

#### DIVISION 2556 – WORKING LLAMAS & ALPACAS

#### Class

1. Junior Division obstacle (any camelid)
2. Senior Division obstacle (any camelid)
3. Pack String (2 or more with packs on first string)

#### DIVISION 2558 – COSTUME CLASS

Dress yourself and your camelid using the same theme.

#### Class

1. Youth to age 18, any camelid

#### DIVISION 2590 – CAMELID SHOWMANSHIP

Showmanship competition is open to all age and all gender camelids. Conformation will not count. Judge will assess training, conditioning, and how well the exhibitor and animal relate to each other. Contestants will be judged on how well the animal is shown to the judge, leads, is under control, and groomed. Judge may ask questions pertaining to the project. Showmanship members are not eligible for Round Robin Competition.

1. Junior Camilid Showman
2. Senior Camelid Showman
