CHANGE IN BREED JUDGING – Exhibitors MUST be present. You will bring your bird to the judging tables when called to do so.

DEPARTMENT RULES

- Judging will be based on the standard of perfection as it reflects the standards of production.
- All poultry must be removed from their transport cages by the exhibitor or representative for veterinary inspection prior to placement in show coops. Any bird found to be afflicted by parasitism including mites or lice, unthrifty, or otherwise unrepresentable will be sent home. It is highly recommended that exhibitors treat their birds for internal and external parasites starting 1 month prior to the fair and according to product labeling.
- All out-of-state birds must meet Montana Department of Livestock animal import regulations; and be from pullorum-free flocks or have had a pullorum test within 30 days.
- Specify breed and color when registering.
- A pair consists of 1 male & 1 female. A trio consists of 1 male & 2 females of the same breed.
- You may enter two birds per class.
- Feeding and cleaning times are 7–9 a.m. and 5:30 - 7 p.m. each day. All birds must be fed, watered and have clean cages by 9 a.m. so the barn is clean for the public. After 3 written warnings of unclean cages or unfed/non-watered animals, entries will be sent home and premiums will be forfeited. Warnings to be posted on cages.

DIVISION 1790 – POULTRY SHOWMANSHIP

Minimum acceptable dress for Showmanship shall be a long-sleeved white shirt, shoes or boots (no canvas tennis shoes) and dark-colored pants. Handlers have the option of dressing to compliment the bird they are showing. All showmen must be neat and clean.

Overall Junior and Senior Champion handlers are expected to show in Round Robin Showmanship Contest if they qualify. Refer to the Livestock Showmanship (4-H division) for details on Round Robin Showmanship.

Novice Showmanship is for the exhibitor who has not been enrolled in the project for more than 2 years & has not received a Best or Reserve Showmanship Award in the Novice division.

The bird used for showmanship DOES NOT have to be exhibited in the breed show, but the bird being used for showmanship MUST be preregistered by August 1st. Birds used for showmanship but not the breed show must remain in the barn for the entirety of the Fair and follow the same check-in and release rules as other poultry exhibits. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of all premiums. Late registrations will not be accepted.
