DEPARTMENT RULES

ID number on the livestock registration & exhibitor tag must be the same as the number on the animal being shown.

In compliance with the USDA, all sheep and goats must have Scrapie tags or other official ID. For further information call 1-866- 873-2824 or visit: www.animalagriculture.org scrapie or www.aphis.usda.gov/vs/scrapie

All mature sheep shown must be shorn after Jan 1st of the current year.

All rams must be registered to be shown; no crossbreds.

Ages determined as of the day of show.

Special awards only presented in classes with at least 3 exhibitors.

Stock trailers must be taken off the grounds

DIVISION 1500 – MARKET SHEEP SHOW & SALE

Rules:

- a. Minimum weight, 110 pounds; maximum weight, 160 pounds.
- b. Only ewe or wether lambs qualify.
- c. All lambs must be slick shorn to the knee or hock within 5 days before show day and shall be clean & reasonably fitted.
- d. Anyone entering class 1 must enter a showman class and class 6.
