## DEPARTMENT RULES

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to care for their animals at all times. Warnings will be given by the Superintendent in the following manner: First offense = verbal warning, 2nd offense = written warning; 3rd offense = withdrawal of animal from Fair and loss of awards and premiums.

Stock trailers must be removed from the grounds immediately after hogs are unloaded.

All hog feed must be stored in a locked feed box.

Animals released at discretion of barn superintendent.

## DIVISION 1400 – MARKET HOG SHOW & SALE

Rules:

- a. **Minimum weight, 220 pounds; maximum weight, 295 pounds**
- b. Only hogs farrowed during the current year are permitted to enter.
- c. All hogs must be properly fitted to compete.
- d. All General Rules for Market Livestock on page 60 apply.
- e. All hogs entered in Class 1 must also enter a Showman class and Class 6
