DEPARTMENT RULES

1. **NO exhibits will be released before 6:00 p.m. Sunday** (unless issued a written release from the department superintendent).
2. Competition open to all persons. Each person may have one exhibit per class unless otherwise noted.
3. All exhibits must have been made within the past two years and should be original and creative. Loose pieces should be glued or made permanent if possible. Because of limited space, the superintendent may impose size limitations at his or her discretion.
4. **PROFESSIONAL** refers to those whose work is produced primarily for the purpose of selling, or who have a diploma, certificate, degree or three or more years of training in arts and/or crafts, or teaching in the arts or crafts.
5. **AMATEUR** refers to those who do not receive income directly from their craft work and have had little or no training in it. The amateur generally does the craft for the pleasure involved.
6. No articles will be allowed which have been purchased, received as a gift, borrowed, or have been previously exhibited.
7. Where there is no competition, awards will be awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or no premium, according to the merit of the exhibit.
8. Exhibitors ages 17 & under must have age printed on the entry tag.
9. Anyone, other than fair officials, caught moving any display will be disqualified from showing.
