



NW Montana Fair 4th Annual Power Wheels Derby

Gameplay: Each contestant will have 2 (or more) balloons attached to their Power Wheels vehicle by fair officials. The goal is to pop the balloons on the other contestants' cars using only the impact of the vehicle. Player is eliminated when all their balloons are popped (or come off the vehicle) and will exit the arena. The last contestant with at least 1 intact balloon wins first place.

Rules and Participation:

- Contestants must be ages 5-10
- Participation is free and awarded to the first 12 completed, qualifying, applications received
- Release and entry forms must be received by race day in order to participate
- A parent or guardian must be present and may aid the participant to and from the arena
- Wristbands will be provided for the participant and up to 2 parents/guardians
- Helmets must be worn at all times- bicycle style or better
- Legs and arms must remain inside vehicle
- No passengers are allowed – driver only
- Car must use original power and batteries
- Battery must be secured away from child in a closed compartment- 12 volt maximum
- Car must have solid sides and doors, open roof is allowed
- No modifications to the car are allowed except traction aid modifications to the wheels and tire reinforcement- no sharp or protruding traction enhancements allowed
- No sharp edges on vehicles; these can be covered with duct tape or otherwise softened
- Decorations allowed and encouraged but must not improve performance of car
- Vehicle will be inspected for safety and rules compliance
- Participants must follow flags and directions of officials at all times
- Officials' decisions will be final
- The NW Montana Fair and its contractors are not responsible for any vehicle damage
